Farewell to My Father Rev. Chris Schriner

Rev.Chris Schriner, Minister Emeritus of Mission Peak UU Congregation in Fremont, will share a Father's Day memoir about an "ordinarily extraordinary" human being, Dale Dudley Schriner. He looks back on his relationship with Dale, from estrangement to reconciliation, and then to the time of

parting.

Rev. Schriner earned a B.A. from the University of Redlands, a Doctorate in Religion from Claremont School of Theology, and an M.S. in Family Counseling from the University of LaVerne. His Honors Thesis at Redlands examined the ethical thought of theologian Paul Tillich and his dissertation at Claremont School of Theology dealt with nuclear weapons policy. He is the author of six books, including Your Living Mind: The Mystery of Consciousness and Why It Matters to You; and Bridging the God Gap: Finding Common Ground Among Believers, Atheists and Agnostics.
